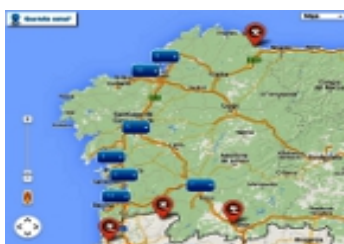

It was approved the decree that will regulate the Inclusion Social Services Portfolio in Galicia, which includes the territorial approach.

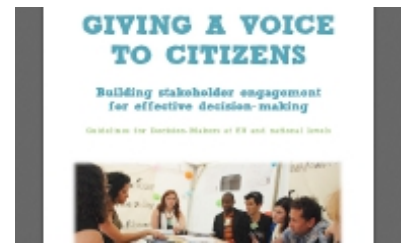
